- A. School-Community Partnerships and Youth Settings Grant - We received word that we did not receive funding from the William T. Grant Foundation for this research grant for Alternative Learning Programs.
- B. Teacher Leader Effectiveness Grant – The District did get this grant but it is based on an approved APPR by the State.
- C. 21<sup>st</sup> Century RFF – The district is currently in the process of writing this grant.
- D. Mental Health Association – Superintendent Suttmeier reported that we received additional funding through the Mental Health Association for the Afterschool Program which allows us to redistribute money for the Junior/Senior High School Afterschool Program.
