Online Summer School Pilot Program vs. Traditional Summer School – Supt. Suttmeier spoke about the Online Summer School Pilot Program being offered this summer by Questar vs. the Traditional Summer School Program and the district's decision to facilitate our own Summer School Program this year to best meet our students' needs.

Response to Intervention (Rtl) Personnel Development Project – Supt. Suttmeier announced that our District has been selected to participate in the Rtl Personnel Development Project for Pre K-8 for 2 ½ years.

Teaching is the Core Grant – Supt. Suttmeier announced that Hudson, Questar and other school districts are applying as a consortium for the Teaching is the Core grant. The primary purpose of the request for proposals (RFP) is to support the applicants in their efforts to improve the quality of educational assessments while reducing the number of assessments that don't contribute to teaching and learning. The RFP can also help identify and develop high-quality assessments already being used for instructional or curricular purposes and at the same time be used for APPR purposes.
