Electronic Devices in Exam Rooms for Proctors:

Reminder, that we follow the NYSED policy for all of our local final exams, not just Regents exams. At the beginning of each test administration, proctors must read the statement below to all students taking secondary-level State examinations:

You cannot have any communications device, including a cell phone, with you during this examination or during any breaks (such as a restroom visit). Such devices include, but are not limited to:

- Cell phones
- Blackberry devices and other PDAs
- iPods, iWatch and MP3 players, wearables
- iPads, tablets, and other eReaders
- Laptops, notebooks, or any other personal computing devices
- Cameras or other photographic equipment
- Headphones, headsets, or in-ear headphones such as earbuds, and
- Any other device capable of recording audio, photographic, or video content,

***If you keep a cell phone or any of these items with you, your examination will be invalidated and you will get no score.**





Summer School:

High School. A student should be recommended for summer school when he or she is failing core subjects with a grade average of at least 50% per course.

Upon completion of summer school, the average of the two final grades (regular school year and summer school) will be the final grade for the course.

Dates: July 10th-Aug. 15th

Monday-Thursday 8:00-10:15 & 10:20-12:35

***Note-** *If a student has Audited a course, they are ineligible to attend Summer School for that course.*
